We believe it is important to involve parents in an early childhood program, so our parents and teachers work together. Our goal is to understand and help each child as a unique individual by integrating the curriculum and activities to meet each child at their level and to provide appropriate play experiences that contribute to the developmental needs of the child.

## OUR STAFF

The Preschool staff consists of the Early Childhood Program Director, qualified credentialed teachers, and several assistant teachers. ## JEWISH VALUES

Our Pre-school program is a part of the Temple. Rabbi David Shofet participates in holiday celebrations and provides the children with a sense of closeness to the synagogue and familiarity with Jewish life. Children are taught values, respect and responsibility.

## TWO TO THREE YEARS OLD PROGRAM

We create several learning centers so that children have the opportunity to explore & learn through art, story time, gym, cooking, music, shabbat ceremony and free play.

## THREE YEAR OLD PROGRAM

Our children gain knowledge and learn new skills with our Judaic curriculum and secular curriculum. Our age appropriate three year old curriculum includes new books, English letters, Hebrew letters, and numbers, shapes & colors.

## FOUR YEAR OLD PROGRAM IS (PRE-K)

The Pre-K program prepares the children for kindergarten. Academics include address, phone number, English and Hebrew letters, math concepts and language skills. Our children will be academically & socially ready for kindergarten.

## ENRICHED PROGRAMMING

All our children participate in gymnastics, music, cooking, Shabbat ceremony, and special activities. The enrichment program is taught by specialists during regular school hours, without additional fees.
